HIP Plus: WHAT IS IT?

HIP Plus is health insurance offered under the Healthy Indiana Plan, HIP. The HIP Plus plan comes with many perks such as:



Does not require payments each time you fill a prescription or visit the doctor



Covers costs of medical services and prescriptions



Also covers dental, vision, and chiropractic services





HIP Plus: AM I ELIGIBLE?

Eligibility for HIP Plus is determined by the following:



Age (19-64 years old)



U.S. citizen or resident



Members in your household



Not eligible for Medicare or other Medicaid plan



Household income





HIP Plus: AM I ELIGIBLE?

HIP Plus: WHAT DOES IT COST?

HIP Plus members must make monthly payments from **\$1-20**. The payment amount is based on household income and number of people in the home.

HIP Plus: ARE THERE OTHER OPTIONS?

HIP BASIC	
ELIGIBILITY:	Earn 100% Federal Poverty Level or below
COVERAGE:	Only medical and prescription
COST(S):	No monthly payments, but requires co-payments every time you fill a prescription or visit the doctor
TIME:	One year with annual redetermination

HIP MATERNITY	
ELIGIBILITY:	Pregnant HIP Members
COVERAGE:	Medical, prescriptions, vision, dental, and chiropractics
COST(S):	No monthly payments
TIME:	During pregnancy and one year after birth

How Do I Get HIP?

STEP 1: PREPARE

IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS:



PROOF OF IDENTITY

Driver's license, social security card, or student ID



PROOF OF US CITIZENSHIP OR IMMIGRATION STATUS

Birth certificate, US passport, alien registration card, or permanent resident card



PROOF OF INCOME

Any pay stubs, child support, SSI, SSDI, or social security income



Note: Only income counts.

HOUSEHOLD INFORMATION:



EACH HOUSEHOLD MEMBER'S INFORMATION

Full names, dates of birth, and social security numbers



CURRENT HEALTH COVERAGE PAYMENTS

Premiums or payments currently being made for adult or child health coverage



FAMILY RELATIONSHIPS

Information on everyone's family relationship, including tax filing status



How Do I Get HIP?

STEP 2: APPLY

1

COMPLETE APPLICATION

Online, in-person at a Division for Family Resources office, or through mail.

2

SUBMIT DOCUMENTS

Within **30 DAYS** of applying, submit all documents



3

CHOOSE YOUR MCE

Managed Care Entities (MCEs) are health insurers who provide assistance to the HIP program. You have the option to pick between 4 providers:

Anthem

MDwise

CareSource

mhs

Each MCE has a different plan. To compare plans, visit bit.ly/planscompared

- ✓ *Tip: Ask your MCE if your doctor and medications are covered by their plan.*



How Do I Get HIP?

STEP 3: CONNECT

Connect with your MCE and make your first POWER account payment

- ✓ *Note: Application approval can take up to 45 days. Watch your mail for the conditional approval letter and welcome packet*
- ✓ *Note: You are not enrolled in HIP Plus until you send your first POWER Account payment to your MCE.*

How to Keep HIP Plus: MAKE MONTHLY PAYMENTS

As a HIP Plus member, you will need to make payments to your Personal Wellness and Responsibility (POWER) account.

POWER ACCOUNT:

A POWER account is a special savings account that HIP members use to pay for their health care expenses.

AMOUNT:

The amount you pay every month will range from **\$1-\$20**. You can pay up to one full year of POWER Account payments in advance.
